Jesu, Jesu, fill us with your love, show us how to serve the neighbors we have from you.

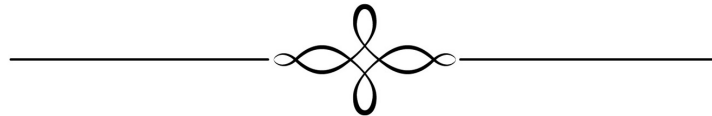
**Knelt at the feet of his friends, silently washing their feet,
