I once was lost, but now am found, was blind but now I see.

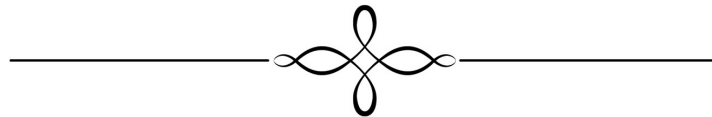
’Twas grace that taught my heart to fear, and grace my fears relieved;
