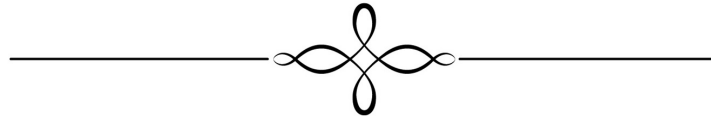
“Dear God, Embracing Humankind”
