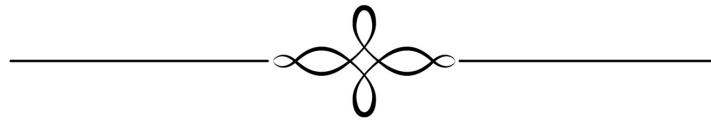
“Help Us Accept Each Other”
