Go, my children, with my blessing you are my own.

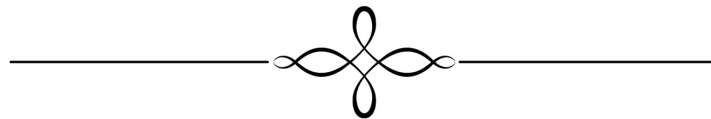
Go, my children, sins forgiven, at peace and pure.
