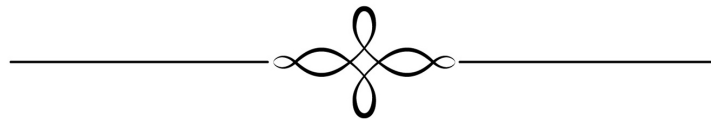
“Joy Dawned Again on Easter Day”
