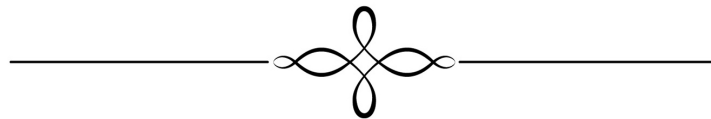
Hymn "Jesus, Lover of My Soul"
