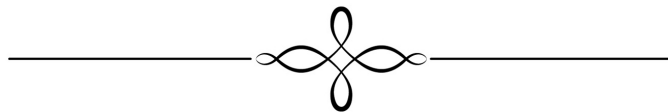
“For the Fruit of All Creation”
