Offering and Morning Prayers

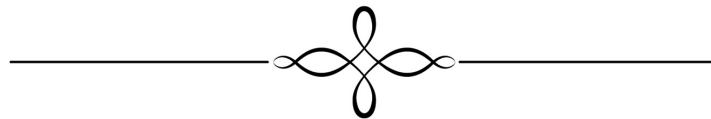
Hymn "God, You Spin the Whirling Planets"
