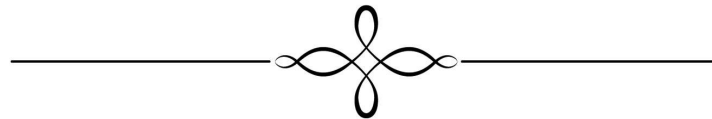
“Lead On Eternal Sovereign”
