Let us rest in this holy place where there is shade and water, food and laughter.

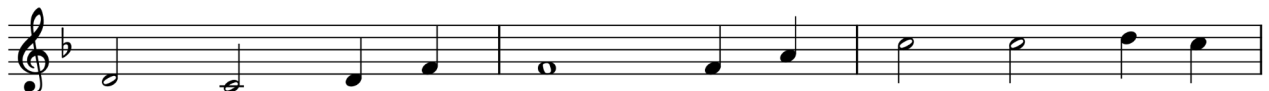

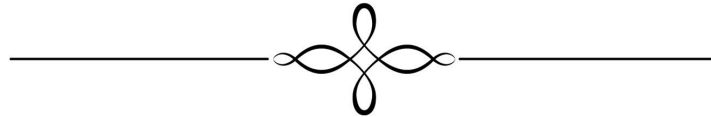
The Prayer of Our Savior
