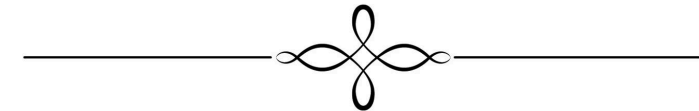
Morning Prayers
